The Special Meeting of the West Grove Borough Council was held on Wednesday, February 17, 2016, in the West Grove Borough Municipal Building. The main purpose of the Special Meeting was to discuss additional funding for the Hometown Streets Grant. The President, Mark Johnson, called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

HOMETOWN STREETS GRANT: The Hometown Street Grant Bids that were received were in excess of \$246,000 for construction and inspection of the awarded funding \$1.1 million for the streetscapes project for curbs and sidewalks to be installed on Evergreen Street, Prospect Avenue and Exchange Place. The purpose of the meeting was to determine how much the Borough of West Grove was willing to contribute towards the excess of \$246,000. Mr. Joseph Banks, DVRPC, said that he had conversations with Planning & Programming at PennDOT and the funding available could be in the \$100,000 range but there was not a guarantee as that money could be allotted to another project. After a lengthy discussion, Mr. Miller moved and Mr. Prosser seconded to contribute the \$246,000 if needed but to initially offer the \$146,000 to see if the PennDOT contribution could be confirmed.

WATER TOWER – PAINTING: Mr. Nichols, Superintendent, requested authorization to proceed with bidding for the painting of the outside of the Borough’s water tank. Mr. Prosser moved and Mr. Freese seconded to authorize the Borough to advertise for the painting of the water tower.
