Subject: West Grove Streetscape Project

Thank you for the cooperation and courtesy that you extended to our crew thus far. As discussed in my Memo of April 14, we are now preparing for the installation of the Concrete Curb and the Driveway Aprons along the north side of Evergreen Street.

Beginning Monday, May 2, we will be closing off the access to your driveways from Evergreen Street. We plan on installing a high line for grade control on Monday (5/2), followed by installation of the concrete curb on Tuesday (5/3) and Wednesday (5/4). Immediately following the installation of the Concrete Curb, we will then move to install the Driveway Aprons in front of each property. Once your Driveway Apron is installed, there will be a seven (7) day waiting period needed to allow the concrete to achieve full strength. Following the seven (7) day waiting period, the driveways will be re-opened for vehicle access. This will be sometime between the 12th and the 16th of May. We will notify you when it is safe to begin reusing your driveway.

Unfortunately our construction operations are subject to the effects of the weather. If you have followed our operation you can see that we work every day possible. That being said, concrete work, especially the Driveway Aprons can not be installed when it is raining or even when there is a high probability of rain in the forecast. So this next operation is much more weather sensitive than the demolition or drainage operations we have been conducting thus far. The bottom line is that if we get rain during the workday, our schedule for this operation will be extended. We will keep you posted as to our progress.

Please make other arrangements for overnight parking during the weeks of May 2 and May 9 when your driveway will not be accessible. If you have questions, Ray Mancini, our Superintendent is available on the job or feel free to call me at our office.

Additional updates will be provided as we work our way through the project.
