CHESCOBUS offers several choices for paying for fares. If using cash, exact change is required since the bus drivers do not make change.

For your convenience, we offer single-trip tickets, 10-trip tickets and monthly passes. Once your order is placed, the tickets and passes are sent via the U.S. mail system.

What are the SCCOOT Zones?

One Zone: Oxford to Shoppes at Longwood Village
OR
Walmart (Kennett Square) to West Chester

Two Zones: Oxford to West Chester

*A Monthly Pass runs from the 1st of the month to the last day of the month and can be used as often as needed during the month.

- Yield designated seats to Seniors & Disabled Riders.
- Don't share your music - use earbuds or headphones.
- Keep phone calls brief, talk in a low voice, don't use the speaker, mute the ringer.
- Check that you have all of your belongings before leaving. Be alert for unattended bags or items.
- Senior Citizens with identification ride free.
- All buses are equipped with wheelchair lifts.
