PUBLIC COMMENT:

FINANCE:

• Sewer Fund PLGIT CD matured on May 29, 2025 and was reinvested, the net interest rate came in at 4.31% for 180 days.

ZONING OFFICER'S MONTHLY REPORT:

• Council Member Mix requested a copy of the failed inspection report for 118 Hillside Avenue and inquired about the stop work order placed on 156 Edgehill.

PUBLIC WORKS:

• 2025 Paving Bid Results were presented. Bids were opened on May 22, 2025, at 3:00PM. The Borough received one response from Long's Asphalt Inc. in the amount of \$145,235.35.

CONSTRUCTION PROJECT UPDATES:

The following updates were provided for the two road construction projects in the Borough:

- Oakland Avenue:
 - East Penn Railroad is requiring us to do drainage work around the railroad crossing on Oakland Avenue. CMS, the original contractor, will begin the installation of a trench drain starting Monday June 9th. We expect full closure of Oakland Avenue during construction time and all pertinent organizations have been notified. Social media and the June newsletter will be used to communicate with residents.
- Prospect Avenue Sidewalk Extension:
 - O We are hung up needing to perform a "Quit Claim" for a small portion of land at the beginning of West Meadow Drive. Engineering believes the land should have been released to PennDOT following dedication of West Meadow Drive, but that did not occur. The Borough needs to claim ownership of the land before we can proceed with the project. This is ultimately pushing back the start of construction.

PUBLIC SAFETY:

Seargent Blue provided an update on police operations.

- Zoning Revision Project Update:
 - Meeting to finalize the updates scheduled with Kevin Myers from the Chester County Planning Commission.
- Park Master Planning Project Update:
 - Chester County Municipal Park & Trail Improvement Grant secured \$100,000; the grant must be utilized by 5/31/2027 and is designated for Memorial Park Phase I.
 - The Borough submitted a PA Statewide Gaming Fund Local Share Grant on 11/26/2024.

- Chester County Community Revitalization Project Grant submitted on March 20, 2025
- 2026 Representative Houlahan Community Project Funding Grant submitted on 4/25/2025
- Comprehensive Plan Update
 - Official Map and Historic Commission/Resource Mapping
