



## **PUBLIC WORKS LABORER JOB POSTING**

Skippack Township is hiring a **full-time Public Works Laborer** to support day-to-day public works operations including roadway maintenance, parks/open space upkeep, facilities support, sewer and stormwater maintenance, and snow/ice operations. This is a hands-on field position that operates tools and equipment and responds to weather events and service needs.

### **About Skippack**

Public Works maintains 46 miles of Township roads, five parks, and Township stormwater and wastewater systems, serving 14,000+ residents across 14 square miles. The approved 2026 Public Works budget is approximately \$2.25 million

### **Key Responsibilities**

- Perform roadway maintenance (pothole patching, pipe/ditch work, shoulder repair, sign installation)
- Maintain parks and open space (mowing, trimming, litter pickup, basic repairs, seasonal tasks)
- Support stormwater operations (inlet cleaning, culvert work, drainage repairs, debris removal)
- Support sewer/wastewater operations as assigned (routine maintenance, repairs, related site work)
- Operate and maintain Township equipment and tools (mowers, loaders, skid steer, dump trucks, hand/power tools)
- Participate in snow and ice operations, including plowing, salting, shoveling, and related overtime/on-call work
- Perform basic preventative maintenance (equipment checks, greasing, fueling, cleanup, reporting issues)

### **Qualifications**

- High school diploma or GED
- Valid driver's license required
- CDL preferred, but not required at hire; must obtain within one year of hire
- Related public works, construction, landscaping, utility, or equipment operation experience preferred
- Ability to perform physical work outdoors in all weather conditions, including lifting, bending, climbing, and working around traffic
- Ability to work nights/weekends and overtime for snow/ice and emergencies
- Volunteer fire experience is a plus; volunteer firefighters are encouraged to apply

### **Compensation & Benefits**

This is a full-time, on-site position with competitive salary and a comprehensive benefits package. Overtime available based on operational needs (snow/ice and emergency response)
